



UNLAWFUL INTERNET GAMBLING ENFORCEMENT ACT (UIGEA)

Federal law, the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 (effective June 1, 2010) and implementing regulations prohibits any person engaged in the business of betting or wagering (as defined in UIGEA) from knowingly accepting payments in connection with the participation of another person in unlawful Internet gambling. Cyprus Federal Credit Union is required to enforce that prohibition. It is Cyprus Federal Credit Union's policy to not open any account for business members held with the intent to conduct or engage in this type of activity. If we discover or determine that an existing business member transacts or engages in unlawful internet gambling as defined by the UIGEA, we reserves the right to restrict services or terminate the account relationship.
